Mathew Wright has spent over a decade working in policing and community safety in the Humber region. After completing a degree in Marketing and Advertising at Lincoln University he worked as a supervisor at Jacksons convenience stores progressing to a marketing role at their Head Office, where he supported the Jacksons stores rebrand to Sainsbury's Locals stores following a takeover.

Moving to North East Lincolnshire Council he undertook marketing for their Children's Services Directorate and co-produced local children's centre communications with service users.
