Born in Hull in 1961 Paul Schofield is a fully qualified, freelance English Heritage Accredited guide. After receiving a degree from Warwick University he returned to Hull in 1982. He completed a guiding course at Hull University, and has been conducting tours of Hull and Beverley since 1988. He has established strong links with the City Council who have awarded him the inaugural Tourism Enterprise Award and the 'extra mile' certificate. He regularly works on behalf of Visit Hull and East Yorkshire and was delighted to win the RYTA Ambassador Award, 2010.
