Vera Bernstein studied metallurgy in Czechoslovakia before she became a refugee in UK after the Soviet invasion of her country. She worked in a precious metal refinery before branching out into market research, further studies of a psychology and business degree and eventually spending almost 25 years as a free-lance translator and interpreter.

She will be telling the story of what happened to her Jewish Slovak born family during the Holocaust.

Vera is part of the charity Generation2Generation: that was formed three and a half years ago in order to train the children, grandchildren and close friends of Holocaust survivors to present the memories of their relatives or friends, many of whom have either died or are now in their 80s and 90s. They feel that it is vital that those experiences should not be forgotten and their aim is to promote a clear message of tolerance and understanding for the generations of the future.
